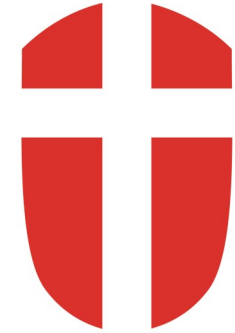

Upon receiving your completed application and fee, we will consider your application and inform you of our decision. After acceptance and receipt of the non-refundable registration fee, we will send your I-20 form, which you must take to the nearest United States Embassy for approval. If you are transferring from a school within the United States, be sure to include your SEVIS identification number along with a copy of your VISA.

Please be advised that Pilgrim Lutheran Christian School is not a boarding school. International students need to make their own arrangements concerning housing while attending our school. Furthermore, Pilgrim Lutheran Christian School is not affiliated with any agencies or individuals who solicit international students to attend schools in the United States. Since there is no legal or implied relationship with such agencies or individuals, all of the money collected by Pilgrim Lutheran Christian School is applied to the necessary tuition and fees for each international student.

Medical insurance is required. Proof of insurance will be required for all students.

In order to ease the transition of new international students into Pilgrim's challenging academic environment, the student's parents will provide tutoring outside of school hours at least two hours per week, until the student is showing appropriate academic progress, understanding of school expectations, and class participation. Tutoring will be provided for at least the first three months. Adequate progress and continuing need for tutoring will be evaluated by the classroom teacher(s) and principal. Before the student starts at Pilgrim, the tutor will meet with the teacher(s) to discuss procedures and expectations.
